CHORAL CLASSES

Where a maximum performance time is indicated in the class description, competitors may be penalised by loss of marks or disqualification if the stipulated period is exceeded.

In classes 26, 27 and 28, Choirs should have not fewer than 12 nor more than 30 voices.
Own Choice of Singing Game, not exceeding 4 minutes, from any Singing Games Book or Section.
Music for the Adjudicator must be sent to Mrs E. Waterston by 13th February 2010.
If accompaniment is required, entrants should provide their own.
