## SCHOOL CHORAL CLASSES

Regulation 14: Any choir, group, orchestra, team etc. entered by a school must consist of pupils on the register of that school at the time the Festival is held. Classes specifically for schools are intended for schools which provide a general education. Entries are welcome from choirs, bands or orchestras from two or more smaller schools where it is necessary for them to combine in order to allow them to participate.

Conductors who have difficulty in obtaining backing tracks for rehearsal should contact the Music Secretary, Mrs M.E. Waterston, for advice.
