SCHOOL CHORAL CLASSES

Any choir, group, orchestra, team etc. entered by a school must consist of pupils on the register of that school at the time the Festival is held. Classes specifically for schools are intended for schools which provide a general education. 'Perth City Campus' is accepted as a school.

Entries are welcome from choirs, bands or orchestras from two or more smaller schools where it is necessary for them to combine in order to allow them to participate.

Where appropriate, primary school pupils may perform with the secondary school with which they are linked.

In all 'Own Choice' classes, details must be shown on the Entry Form.

A photocopy of the item/s must be submitted in accordance with regulations 19 or 20.
