## SCHOOL CHORAL CLASSES

Any choir, group, orchestra, team etc. entered by a school must consist of pupils on the register of that school at the time the Festival is held. Classes specifically for schools are intended for schools which provide a general education. 'Perth City Campus' is accepted as a school. Entries are welcome from choirs from two or more smaller schools where it is necessary for them to combine in order to allow them to participate. Where appropriate, primary school pupils may perform with the secondary school with which they are linked.

### **Class 079 Gaelic Choral Singing, Secondary school age - unison**

Own Choice of two contrasting unison songs selected from any An Comunn Gaidhealach publication.  
Total time not to exceed 6 minutes.

### **Class 080 Gaelic Choral Singing, Secondary school age - harmony**

Own Choice of two contrasting 2-part harmony songs selected from any An Comunn Gaidhealach publication. Total time not to exceed 6 minutes.

## **NON-SCHOOL CHORAL CLASSES**
