LARGE ENSEMBLES

Note Regulation 4: The Festival is not responsible for supplying music stands or instruments. The onus is on the conductor/performer to ensure that the required equipment is available.

Note Regulation 28: In all competitive classes, teachers and instructors must not play with groups or ensembles, except at Elementary or Intermediate level of bands and orchestras, where one non-pupil may play in order to allow a group to perform.

In all 'Own Choice' classes, details must be shown on the Entry Form.

A photocopy of the item/s must be submitted in accordance with regulation 20.

Please note that, in accordance with regulation 20, photocopies should NOT be attached to the entry form

BRASS ENSEMBLES

In classes 421 - 423, all scored parts must be played by a pupil, except as in Regulation 28 (above).
No piano part permitted unless in original score.

Class 421 Brass Ensemble, Schools (Elementary)

Own Choice, not exceeding 6 minutes.

Class 422 Brass Ensemble, Schools (Intermediate)

Own Choice, not exceeding 8 minutes.

Class 423 Brass Ensemble, Schools (Advanced)

Award: The George Annan Trophy to be awarded to the Winning School Brass Band

Own Choice, not exceeding 10 minutes.

Class 424 Brass Band, non-school

Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 10 minutes.

WIND BANDS

In Classes 425 - 427, all scored parts must be played by a pupil, except as in Regulation 28 (above).
No piano accompaniment is permitted.
Use of amplified Bass Guitar is permitted.

Class 425 Wind Band, Schools (Elementary) To include at least Woodwind and Brass.

Own Choice, not exceeding 5 minutes.

Class 426 Wind Band, Schools (Intermediate) To include at least Woodwind and Brass.

Own Choice, not exceeding 8 minutes.

Class 427 Wind Band, Schools (Advanced) To include at least Woodwind and Brass.

Award: The Armstrong Award presented by the Armstrong family, Glencarse

Own Choice of items of a minimum standard American Wind Band Grade 3, not exceeding 10 minutes.

Class 428 Wind Band, non-school

Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 10 minutes.

STRING ORCHESTRAS

In Classes 429 - 431, all scored parts must be played by a pupil, except as in Regulation 28 (above).

No piano accompaniment is permitted.

Use of amplified Bass Guitar is permitted.

- Class 429 String Orchestra, Schools (Elementary)** Not less than 8 players.
Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 6 minutes.
- Class 430 String Orchestra, Schools (Intermediate)** Not less than 8 players.
Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 8 minutes.
- Class 431 String Orchestra, Schools (Advanced)** Not less than 10 players.
Award: The String Orchestra Cup presented by Mrs Margaret Miller
Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 10 minutes.
- Class 432 String Orchestra, non-school**
Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 10 minutes.

ORCHESTRAS

In Classes 433 - 435, all scored parts must be played by a pupil, except as in Regulation 28 (above).

No piano accompaniment is permitted.

- Class 433 Orchestra, Schools (Elementary)** Not less than 16 players.
To include at least String and Wind Instruments.
Own Choice of two contrasting Test Pieces, playing time not exceeding 5 minutes.
- Class 434 Orchestra, Schools (Intermediate)** Not less than 16 players.
To include at least String and Wind Instruments.
Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 8 minutes.
- Class 435 Orchestra, Schools (Advanced)** Not less than 16 players.
To include at least String and Wind Instruments.
Award: The Jean Harkess Memorial Trophy awarded to the winning School Orchestra (Advanced)
Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 10 minutes.
- Class 436 Orchestra, non-school**
Own Choice, playing time not exceeding 10 minutes.
