## SPEECH RECITAL

### **Class 431      Speech Recital Class**

A 12-15 minute programme to be prepared from the work of one author. This should be presented with an introduction to the author and his work. Competitors will memorise one piece (prose or poetry) to last approximately 3 minutes, which the adjudicator will hear. Competitors will also introduce and comment upon the other pieces and will be asked to read one of these, chosen by the adjudicator. Quality and balance of programme will be taken into account.

## PUBLIC SPEAKING

### **Class 432      Prepared Speech, aged 11 - 12**

Performers will deliver a speech, on one of the following topics:  
a hobby, a book, a film or a holiday, not to exceed 2 mins.

### **Class 433      Prepared Speech, aged 13 - 14**

Performers will deliver a speech, on a topic of their own choice, not to exceed 2 mins.

### **Class 434      Prepared Speech, aged 15 - 17**

Performers will deliver a speech, on a topic of their own choice, not to exceed 3 mins.

### **Class 435      Prepared Speech, aged 18 & over**

Performers will deliver a speech, on a topic of their own choice, not to exceed 4 mins.
